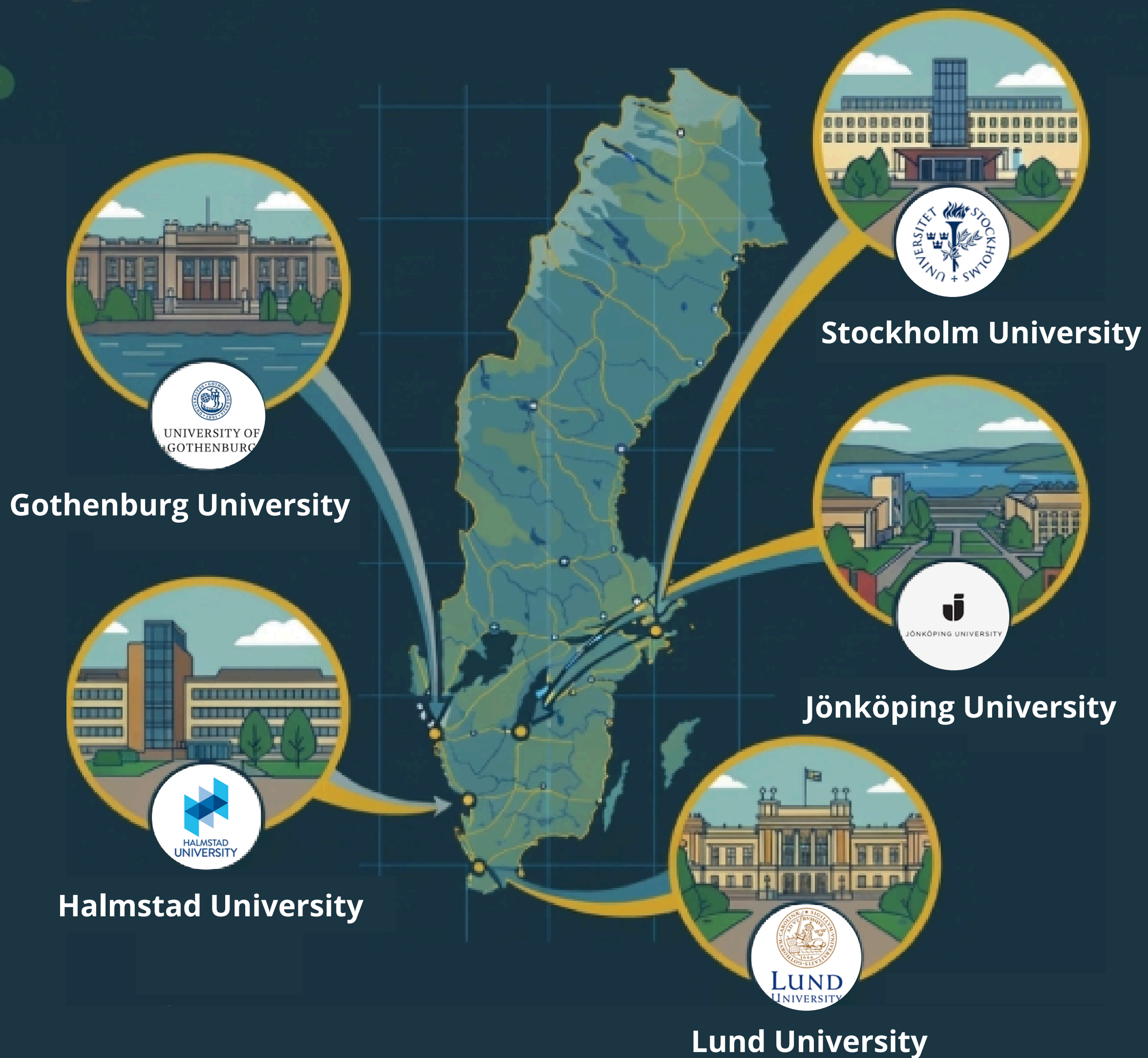


# Participating Universities
