	1. Copy of air ticket booking (we advise you not to pay for air tickets before your visa has been granted)

	1. Copy of certificate of medical travel insurance (€30,000 ⇄ ¥4,000,000 minimum coverage for medical expenses)	
<b>F)</b>	<b><i>Financial proof - It is exempted if the purpose is business and the cost is paid by the company</i></b>

<b>G)</b>	<b><i>Application fee - If you have <u>NOT</u> applied online</i></b>

<b>H)</b>	<b><i>Return envelope - If you want your passport returned by post</i></b>

Remarks:

- You may submit more supporting documents on your own judgement to strengthen the application. Then, put a check mark on "Others".
- The embassy might ask you to submit some additional documents as needed after checking the basic required documents.
- It is very important to submit all the required documents when visiting the embassy. If you fail to submit any of the required documents at that time, the application will be processed only with the documents that you will have brought then. That failure might lead the application to a negative decision.
- The application may however be rejected even if all the required documents on this list are submitted.
- Some more documents from the guardians will be needed for a minor's application.
