### **Minors (under 18 years) – Ethiopia**

Please note: Checklist applicable for the purpose of your travel need to be fulfilled, in addition to this checklist.

	<b>Required documents for minors in Ethiopia travelling to Sweden/Norway</b>	<b>Check</b>
	Application for Schengen Visa –application form completed and signed by custodian.	
	Passport <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Original passport valid for travel to Sweden. The passport validity must exceed the planned stay in the Schengen Area with at least three months. The passport must have been issued within the last ten years.</li><li>• Complete photocopies of original passport, except blank pages.</li><li>• Previous passport in original if a new passport has been issued within the last year.</li></ul>	
	Proof of visa fee payment (bank deposit slip) or proof of fee exemption (if applicable).	
	Individual medical travel insurance valid in all Schengen countries for the duration of the stay, covering the costs of at least EUR 30,000 which could arise as a result of emergency medical assistance, emergency hospitalization or medical repatriation.	
	1 color photo not more than 6 months old, passport size (45 mm x 35 mm), full face and taken against a light background.	
	Children under 12 years are exempted from submitting fingerprints. Applicants who submitted fingerprints in a previous application and were granted a Schengen visa within the last 59 months they are exempted from resubmitting a new fingerprint.	
	Preliminary ticket booking or travel itinerary.	
	For non-Ethiopian nationals: Ethiopian residence permit or proof of legal stay in any other country within the Embassy's coverage area, valid at least three months beyond the planned stay in the territory of the Member States.  In case the applicant does not intend to return to Ethiopia: proof that the entry to country of origin or any other third country is guaranteed.	
	Birth certificate for the minor.	
	Certified certified copies of ID/passport of both parents.	
	Legalized written consent letter from both parents if the minor travels alone, or from the parent that is not accompanying the child when travelling.	
	If either one of the parents is absent or deceased, this must be supported by a court decision or a death certificate when applicable.	
	If the legal guardian is someone else apart from the parent stated in the birth certificate a custody order must be submitted proving the legal guardianship.	
	A letter from school containing the minor's name, name of parents, grade, number of years at school, school holidays, contact details, date and name of school representative.	

	If the minor travels with a group: a complete list of names of all group members travelling and name of person in charge of the group.

**Please note:**

- On 29th April 2024 the Council of the European Union decided to temporarily suspend certain elements of the EU visa code that regulates the issuing of visas to Ethiopian nationals. The suspension decision applies to all applications lodged from 1st June 2024 by Ethiopian nationals falling within the scope of the measures.
- The processing time of 15 calendar days is no longer applied. The normal processing time is set to 45 days for all cases subject to the visa restrictions.
- Only single-entry visas can be granted.
- Holders of diplomatic and service passport are no longer exempted from the visa fee.
- The possibility to waive requirements regarding the documents that visa applicants must submit is removed. This means that applicants must submit a complete set of supporting documents proving that the entry conditions are met with each application. Missing documents can result in a refusal.
- All submitted documents must be in English or in Swedish.
- This decision does not apply to nationals of Ethiopia applying for a visa who are family members of a Union citizen to whom Directive 2004/38/EC applies or family members of a national of a third country enjoying a right of free movement equivalent to that of Union citizens under an agreement between the Union and a third country. It also does not apply to family members of British citizens covered by the withdrawal agreement between the EU and the UK.
- The decision also does not apply to citizens of Ethiopia who apply for Schengen visa to participate in meetings with international intergovernmental organizations or at international conferences organized by a Member State.
- Applications can be submitted up to 6 months before the intended travel before the intended travel. Please note that the days are counted from when the Embassy has received the application and not when the application was submitted at VFS Global. The transportation time between the application centers and Nairobi is published on the website of VFS Global.
