The passport must have been issued within the last ten years. Complete photocopies of original passport, except blank pages. Previous passport in original if a new passport has been issued within the last year. 	
Pı	roof of visa fee payment (bank deposit slip) or proof of fee exemption (if applicable).	
co	ndividual medical travel insurance valid in all Schengen countries for the duration of the stay, overing the costs of at least EUR 30,000 which could arise as a result of emergency medical ssistance, emergency hospitalization or medical repatriation.	
	color photo not more than 6 months old, passport size (45 mm x 35 mm), full face and sken against a light background.	
	pplicants who submitted fingerprints in a previous application and were granted a Schengen is a within the last 59 months are exempted from resubmitting a new fingerprint.	
cc	or non-Ethiopian nationals: Ethiopian residence permit or proof of legal stay in any other buntry within the Embassy's coverage area, valid at least three months beyond the planned cay in the territory of the Member States.

Letter of acceptance from the Member State's educational institution. The letter must contain the following information:
- the applicant's personal data
- indications of the course that the applicant has been admitted to/what research
work to be done
- course/research duration
- information about the language in which the study program /courses will be
held/taught
- who will be responsible for supporting the applicant financially during the stay in the
Member State
- date and contact details from the Member State's educational institution.
Signed letter from your educational institution in Ethiopia containing your personal data, name of institution, contact details, course enrollment and number of years at institution.
Final qualification achieved: either High School Education Certificate entitling to access to
University OR Post-secondary education, Diploma or Bachelor which has to be: Certified "true
copy" from the relevant Institution, College or University duly legalized by the competent
authority. Accompanied by the transcript and student academic record.
Please note that the Embassy will consider your socioeconomic situation in your home country or in your country of residence if not the same. It is your responsibility to submit
any other documents related to personal ties in Ethiopia, such as marriage certificate, title
deeds or lease agreements.

Please note:

- On 29th April 2024 the Council of the European Union decided to temporarily suspend certain elements of the EU visa code that regulates the issuing of visas to Ethiopian nationals. The suspension decision applies to all applications lodged from 1st June 2024 by Ethiopian nationals falling within the scope of the measures.
- > The processing time of 15 calendar days is no longer applied. The normal processing time is set to 45 days for all cases subject to the visa restrictions.
- Only single-entry visas can be granted.
- Holders of diplomatic and service passport are no longer exempted from the visa fee.
- > The possibility to waive requirements regarding the documents that visa applicants must submit is removed. This means that applicants must submit a complete set of supporting documents proving that the entry conditions are met with each application. Missing documents can result in a refusal.
- All submitted documents must be in English or in Swedish.
- > This decision does not apply to nationals of Ethiopia applying for a visa who are family members of a Union citizen to whom Directive 2004/38/EC applies or family members of a national of a third country enjoying a right of free movement equivalent to that of Union citizens under an agreement between the Union and a third country. It also does not apply to family members of British citizens covered by the withdrawal agreement between the EU and the UK.
- The decision also does not apply to citizens of Ethiopia who apply for Schengen visa to participate in meetings with international intergovernmental organizations or at international conferences organized by a Member State.
- Applications can be submitted up to 6 months before the intended travel before the intended travel. Please note that the days are counted from <a href="https://www.when.the.com/when.the.c
