Foreword

When Sweden and Vietnam established diplomatic relations on January 10, 1969, Sweden became the first Western country to recognise the government of Vietnam. It marked the beginning of a relationship that has grown and evolved over decades but remained rooted in solidarity and trust. From being an aid partner for 46 years, to now focus more on political dialogue and trade, Sweden sees Vietnam as an important partner. Sweden stands among the top ten EU trading partners of Vietnam, a position further strengthened by the EU–Vietnam Free Trade Agreement.

A number of well-known Swedish companies have established a strong presence in Vietnam, including ABB, AstraZeneca, Atlas Copco, Electrolux, IKEA, Oriflame, SKF, Tetra Pak and Volvo – to name just a few. While many of these companies have been in Vietnam for over 30 years, we have also seen growing interest from Vietnamese businesses in Sweden; Nutifood opened a research centre in 2021 and FPT Software established its first office in 2024.

It is in this context that we are pleased to present the Swedish footprints publication. We hope it will serve as a useful resource for both Swedish and Vietnamese businesses and help to further deepen our bilateral trade and investment relationship.

Sweden-Vietnam: 56 Years of Partnership

The year 1969 was an important milestone that marks the official beginning of diplomatic relations between Sweden and Vietnam. Following that historical moment, the two countries' bilateral ties have been continuously strengthened through multi-faceted cooperations. After 46 years of aid development, today Sweden sees Vietnam as an important trade partner. The recent Free Trade Agreement between the European Union and Vietnam has not only incentivised trading activities but also fostered investment interest among European as well as Swedish business communities. Many Swedish companies already have presence in Vietnam for a long time – ABB, AstraZeneca, Atlas Copco, Electrolux, Ericsson, Hitachi Energy, IKEA, Oriflame, SKF, Tetra Pak, and Volvo to name a few.

Increasingly, Sweden-Vietnam relation is characterised by a strong focus on innovation

and sustainability, which is really in the DNA of Sweden. Placing sustainability on top of its agenda, Sweden leverages innovation to achieve the goal of becoming net-zero by 2045. Adding to its long history of innovation, this commitment could be seen as one of key factors for Sweden's leading position in several global innovation rankings.

Sweden and Vietnam share many similarities when it comes to innovation. With the aim to become high-income country by 2045 and net-zero by 2050, Vietnam views innovation as the main driver to achieve this goal. The establishment of the National Innovation Centre in recent year has demonstrated Vietnam's commitment to accelerate and leverage innovation for a rapid and sustainable development. In two consecutive years 2022 and 2023, Vietnam is ranked as the second most innovative economy within the lower middle-income group, just after India.

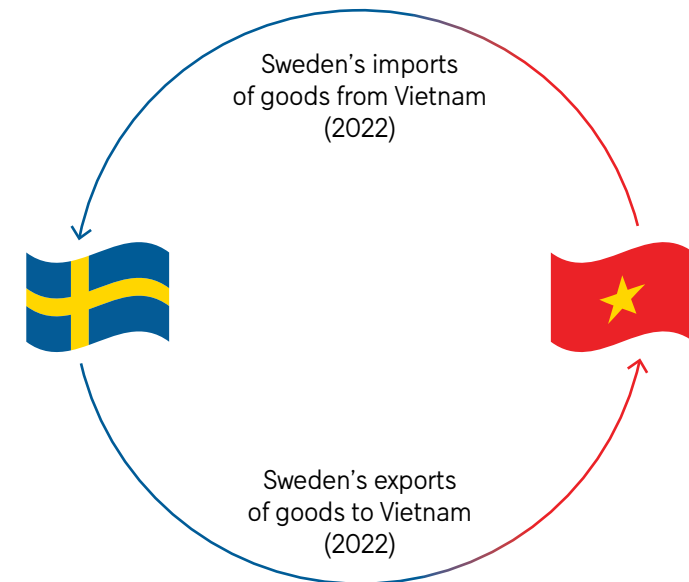

The Swedish Export Credit System



The Swedish Export Credit Agency - EKN

EKN is commissioned by the government to promote Swedish exports and the internationalisation of Swedish companies. EKN does so by insuring export companies and banks against the risk of non-payment in export transactions, thereby enabling them to conduct more secure export transactions. EKN's activities are financed by the guarantee holders' premiums. EKN works with the big global companies as well as the very small ones, and guarantee the export business to over 130 countries.

The Swedish Export Credit System

To facilitate and promote exports and the internationalisation and competitiveness of Swedish industry, Sweden offers a government-backed export credit system. This system facilitates the financing of transactions with Swedish exporting companies and has strong benefits for all parties involved. The support is made up of two organisations:



offers guarantees for payments and financing. The guarantees give international customers competitive financing terms, while lowering the risk for Swedish exporting companies and commercial banks.



provides long term funding for Swedish export related transactions. Enjoying a high credit rating, SEK can offer favourable loans to facilitate export deals.

How to finance a Swedish export contract

Export transactions often involve large contracts requiring long repayment periods. A common form of financing is an export credit provided by a commercial bank – a buyer’s credit.

Financing of a large Swedish export contract usually involves a commercial bank as the arranger. The bank, or a group of banks, arranges and administers a loan to the buyer in the export contract. EKN is the guarantor, taking the repayment risk with a small portion of the risk retained by the arranging bank. SEK can provide funding, and also sometimes assume the role as arranger, usually jointly with one or more banks. See an example below.



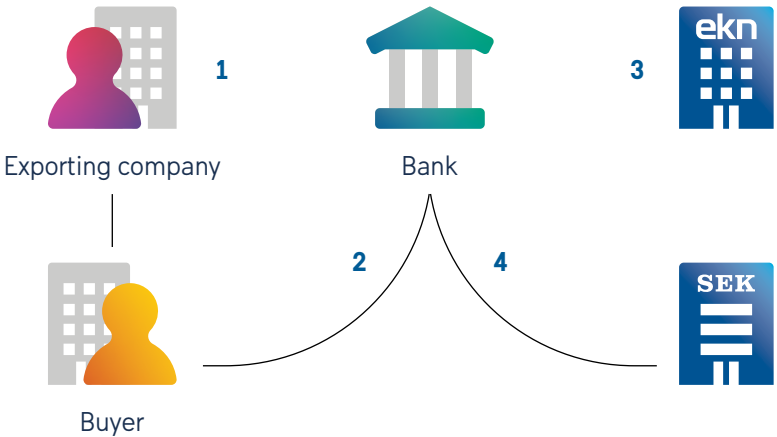
*The Commercial Interest Reference Rate, CIRR, is a state-supported interest rate administered by SEK. It allows exporting companies to offer their customers funding at a favourable fixed interest rate.

Benefits

- The exporting company receives upfront payment and can still offer customers competitive financing.
- The buyer receives access to attractive financing with long tenures. An export credit also diversifies the buyer’s loan portfolio and reduces the use of bank credit limits.
- The commercial bank minimises its exposure to risk and capital loss thanks to the EKN guarantee. The bank also gains access to attractive funding options with SEK, which improves their balance sheet.
- With an EKN guarantee, the commercial bank can turn to SEK for optional funding of the loan. The loan is assigned to SEK together with the rights under the EKN guarantee. The loan is now on SEK’s balance sheet, while the bank retains the 5% non- covered portion.

How it works

To ensure the best conditions for all parties involved it is very important for the exporter and bank to contact EKN and SEK at an early stage. This is to enable structuring of the business agreements regarding securities, capital structure, and being OECD-compliant. In our environmental and social due diligence, EKN and SEK comply with international standards. Below you will find a schematic outline for a buyer's credit. Please note that the steps can take place simultaneously.



1. The exporting company and the buyer sign a sales contract. Payment is to be made at delivery, or with a short credit period.
2. A bank signs a loan agreement with the buyer.
3. The bank applies for a guarantee – preferably before the contract is signed, and receives an offer from EKN. EKN normally covers 95% of the loan. The bank notifies EKN of disbursements and receives the guarantee. This is when the premium is paid.
4. If the bank is looking for funding they will have contacted SEK and received an offer, before signing the contract. The bank will then assign the loan as well as the rights under the EKN guarantee to SEK.

The bank retains the 5% risk share on the borrower as well as their obligations to EKN, and administers the loan. If the borrower fails to pay according to the loan agreement, EKN will indemnify SEK directly.

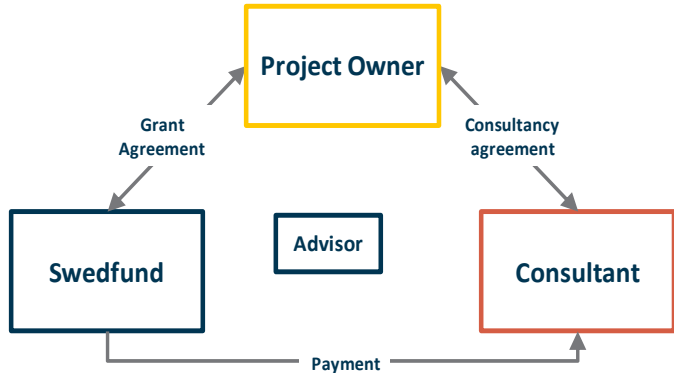

Process overview

Key aspects

- Swedfund's grant financing is used to engage independent, high-quality consultants and experts.
- Two agreements in the structure: 1) Grant Agreement and 2) Consultancy Agreement between the Project Owner and Consultant.
- The Consultant is selected after a competitive sourcing process.
- Swedfund must approve: (i) Terms of Reference, (ii) selection of consultant and (iii) the consultancy agreement.
- Swedfund engages a technical expert (advisor) to support and facilitate the process.
