The Embassy of Sweden in Lusaka, Zambia (hereinafter called the Embassy) is conducting a limited procurement of a Market systems Development consultant to carry out an external review of Market System Development interventions by the organisation Musika Development Initiative (hereinafter called Musika). The assignment is further described in the attached Terms of Reference, Annex 1.

With this letter we would like to invite you to submit a proposal for undertaking of the assignment. The tender should be submitted no later than 16 March 2020. A contract will be signed with one (1) tenderer. The tender is valid until 31st of December 2020.

1. Tender documents

Proposals must include the following:

- 1. Technical proposal, including methodological framework/ approach and time plan in line with what is specified in specific requirements in the attached Terms of Reference. The technical proposal should not be longer than 20 pages (excluding annexes).
- 2. The total cost for the assignment shall not exceeded 1,400, 000 SEK (including reimbursables) The cost includes consultancy fees, reimbursable costs, cost related to revisions and all other costs related to the assignment.
- 3. No guarantee of obtaining a certain volume is provided.
- 4. CVs of all team members suggested under this assignment
- 5. Collectively as a team demonstrating references to at least five (5) other assignments during the last 5 years covering previous experiences from monitoring and evaluation consulting and making markets work for the poor (M4P) implementation in Zambia or a similar country.

Tenders submitted shall cover the entire assignment described in Annex 1. The tenderer is not entitled to claim compensation for work or other costs associated with participating in the procurement.

Interviews might be carried with the tenderers as part of the evaluation process.

2. Contracting period

A contract will be signed with the principal consultant. The total contract period shall not exceed 3 calendar months. The contract's start date is estimated at latest: 20th April 2020.

All consultants intended to be engaged by the Principal Consultant within this assignment, are subject to a no-objection by the Embassy.

4. Assessment criteria

The Embassy will use the following criteria for choosing the best proposal.

Price will be assessed according to the following model:

The tender response that submitted the lowest price achieves maximal price points. The other proposals achieve points according to percentage difference between the individual proposed price and the tender with the lowest price.

Price point = (Lowest tender price / Individual tender price) * Max point price criterion

The contract will be awarded to the most economically advantageous tender, as determined according to best price-quality ratio in accordance with the specified prerequisites for the assignment in ToR, Annex 1.

If a tender appears to be abnormally low, the Embassy is obligated to request that the tenderer explain the low price or cost. If the tenderer has failed to explain the low price or cost in a satisfactory manner, the Embassy will reject the tender.

5. Confidentiality

As soon as the award decision has been sent to all tenderers, all documents relating to the procurement, including tenders, shall become subject to the principle of public information access. If a tenderer considers that it may suffer damages if information provided by the tenderer in the tender should become public, the tenderer shall submit a written request for confidentiality in said tender, which must specify a) the information to which the request for confidentiality pertains and b) what damages would be suffered by the tenderer should said information be divulged.

Upon request for the submission of tenders, the Embassy will in each case review any request for confidentiality submitted by a tenderer. The Embassy's assessment regarding confidentiality may be subject to examination by an administrative court. The Embassy can therefore not guarantee that the information in the tender will not be disclosed to the public.
